

Koi Feeds

STARTER

- Especially formulated for first feeding fry and fingerling
- Nearly free of dust and fines which can be detrimental to small fish
- High levels of quality fish and animal protein
- Utilizes marine oils, beta glucans, pigments and high vitamin levels, including stabilized vitamin C
- Available Sizes: #0, #1, #2 & #3 Crumble

GROWER

- Sinking dry crumbles from starter-to-pellet transition
- Nutritionally complete and balanced
- Main components are high quality fish and animal proteins
- Finely ground to ensure superior digestibility and that fish receive a full complement of nutrients daily
- Available Sizes: #3 and #4 Crumble

EXTR 450

- Extruded floating or slow sinking pellets for highly efficient growth
- Extrusion also means fewer fines and less pond waste
- Extra vitamins and stabilized vitamin C are standard
- Available Sizes: 1/16", 3/32", 1/8", 5/32", 3/16" & 1/4"

KOI STAPLE

- Extruded floating feed formulated to maintain water clarity
- Utilizes quality ingredients that are highly digestible by koi
- Does not contain color enhancing pigments
- Available Sizes: 1/8" and 3/16"

KOI COLOR

- Extruded floating feed formulated to maintain water clarity
- Utilizes quality ingredients that are highly digestible by koi
- Contains pigments to enhance the red, yellow, orange and blue-green coloration of your koi
- Available Sizes: 1/8" and 3/16"

MEDICATED

- Provides added palatability and digestibility at a time when the fish are not feeding readily
- Oxytetracycline at 4000 and 8000 g/ton
- Romet TC in 5 lb. sacks
- Available Sizes: #0, #1, #2 & #3 & #4 Crumble, 3/32", 1/8", 5/32"
